

Homebound Vaccination Program

For Older Adults and People with Disabilities

The Philadelphia Department of Public Health is pleased to announce the Homebound Vaccination Program, designed to reach homebound individuals with COVID-19 vaccine in their own homes. This program is available for any individual who is homebound or for anyone who would have difficulty being vaccinated at a clinic due to a disability.

Personal Care Attendants, family, and any other caregivers or residents of the individual's household are eligible to be vaccinated under this program.
